Open Access

Alternative Textbook Initiative

OU Libraries' Alternative Textbook Initiative displaces the cost of textbooks by supporting OU faculty's adoption or creation of alternative textbooks. DATA Grants

OU Libraries is piloting a new DATA (**Data Acquisition and Transmission Award**) grant program. All OU-Norman affiliated faculty, staff, and students can apply for funds, up to \$5,000, to acquire data sets for use in research or instruction. Preference is given to applications which result in the permanent acquisition of unrestricted-use data sets.

The Fall 2016 application deadline is October 1 and the Spring/Summer 2017 deadline is March 1.

Library Instruction

Interlibrary Loan (ILL) and Sooner Xpress

Interlibrary Loan is a free service that obtains books, articles, and other materials not owned by University of Oklahoma Libraries.

Sooner Xpress is the University of Oklahoma Norman Campus Document Delivery Service for faculty, staff and students. Sooner Xpress provides digitized copies of journal articles, or book chapters, and books from the OU Libraries' collection to faculty, staff, and students for their personal research.

SHAREOK

SHAREOK is the joint institutional repository for both the University of Oklahoma Libraries and Oklahoma State University Libraries. As the home for the intellectual output of both communities, contents include digital dissertations, faculty publications, digital special collections, open access publications, open educational resources and more.
